5/02/17 Report of the Clerk including actions from previous meeting:

Actions

- a) Cemetery
 - Two burials taking place in February 2018
 - Fees for burials need to be reviewed
- b) Playground/Playing Field/Pavilion
 - Nothing to report
- c) Christmas Lighting
 - Derbyshire County Council have agreed on this occasion to pay for the damaged Christmas lighting.
- d) Barrier for Jubilee Playing Field
 - Council agreed for the contractor to install the restrictive height barrier at the entrance to Jubilee playing field
- e) Highway replacement mirror
 - Clerk presented several quotes for replacement mirror, Cllr Clarke to confirm size before ordering a replacement
- f) Drainage and Septic Tank at Jubilee Playing Field
 - Currently the council do not have the relevant funding for either the drainage issue to be addressed or for the septic tank to be replaced. Clerk to investigate funding streams
- g) Parking at Straw Lane and on A61
 - Council had received complaints about parking on Straw Lane and A61, brief discussion was had and it was decided to monitor situation
