Cllr A Cooper attended from North East Derbyshire District Council. He informed the council of ongoing district issues. Cllr K Gillott reported on County items including the restructure of senior staff. Councillor raised the issue of the footways on the B6104 and the weeding that needs to be done. KG said that County has to prioritise the footpaths that require attention and the footways that are used by the most footfall take priority.

Cllr K Gillott gave a presentation about the Police to the council in his role as Deputy Police Commissioner for Derbyshire.

Cllr A Cooper left the meeting at 7.35pm.

##### 5/07/17 Report of the Clerk including actions from previous meeting:

###### Actions

- a) Cemetery
  - Gates have been fitted at the cemetery.
  - Clerk requested replacement bench for the current damaged bench.
  - Drainage is an ongoing issue, the report commissioned by the council reveals broken pipes and a hidden manhole. Council need to revisit this issue in the new 6 months.
- b) Playground/Playing Field/Pavilion
  - New play equipment in place
  - NEDDC fitted new gate but there was an issue with it on installation, contractor having to issue new gate
- c) Parish Issues
  - Council awaiting information regarding 106 grant from new housing at Woolley Moor.
  - Belated hanging basket licence has been retrospectively applied for.
  - All correspondence has been dealt with.
  - Mirror for junction at Woolley Moor. This is an ongoing issue, clerk to obtain quote for new mirror.

##### 6/07/17 Decisions

- a) A request has been made to the council to adopt the telephone kiosk in Woolley Moor and to have a defibrillator fitted in it. Council declined the request to adopt the phone kiosk as it is the more modern version, not the traditional red, although they liked the proposal of a defibrillator. **Noted** Clerk to contact residents for suggestions of location for defibrillator.
- b) After the fitting of the new play equipment a space has been left in the play area that could accommodate a small new piece of equipment. Currently, there is no monies available for another piece of equipment however the clerk suggested a picnic table. Noted postpone until next meeting with examples and quotes.
- c) Following the erection of the new play equipment the old equipment is looking tired. Clerk requested approval for paint to be purchased and for the handy man to paint the swing-set and see saw in matching colours. **Resolved** to approve.
- d) S137 donation requested from Chair of North East Derbyshire District Council. **Approved** £250

- e) A request had been received for a charity match to be played at Woolley Moor. This will cost the council £55 as it is out of season and the pitch will require an additional cut. **Resolved** to approve the use of the pitch.
