5/9/16 Report of the Clerk including actions from previous meeting:

Actions

- a) Burial Ground inspection undertaken. Burial took place on 6th September 2016. Clerk still awaiting quotes from contractors regarding the cemetery entrance.
- b) Cemetery Lodge – no actions
- c) Playground/Playing Field/Pavilion inspection undertaken.
- d) Correspondence/emails and post all dealt with including complaint from residents regarding the trees on Beresford Lane. Clerk has contacted NEDDC regarding the matter and although the trees are due to be pruned there are no plans to remove them.
The quote for the solar Christmas trees was presented to council and approved.
A notice of a temporary road closure on the B6014 from 12th to 16th September had been received from DCC.
- e) The new waste bin supplied by the parish had been put in place at Handley and a new dog waste bin supplied by NEDDC has been placed at the top of Highstairs Lane (at the junction with A61).

- g) LATE ITEM Derbyshire County Council have asked councils to confirm if they wish to members of the snow warden scheme for 2016. Councillors agreed to remain in the scheme.
